ハロウインの歴史 ~本校 ALT Katie 先生に聞く~

Halloween originally came from other Christian and Native European holidays around the same time, when people would pray for the dead. These holidays mostly happened during Fall, as the weather cools down and plants start to die as well. (日本のお盆ですね。)

ハロウイン in アメリカ

Kids will wear costumes and go out to their neighbor's houses to "Trick or Treat", where the neighbors give kids candy. The costumes are often scary, such as witches, ghosts, or zombies. Halloween parties are also very common in the US. Both adults and children will wear costumes and come together with friends and food, including candy, apple cider, and pumpkin-flavored treats. Campfires and pumpkin carving are popular activities.

ハロウイン in フィリピン

A week before Halloween, people clean the graves of their relatives. Halloween is celebrated on October 31st. On Halloween night, Filipinos might trick-or-treat or buy supplies for All Saints' Day, like flowers and candles. On November 1, families visit cemeteries to spend time at their loved ones' graves until nightfall. November 2, known as All Souls' Day, is a quieter day for those who want to visit the cemetery without the crowds.
